DISTRICT LEVEL COMPETITION 2025-26 SCHEDULE

- The competition will be conducted on 24th November 2025 for all groups, i.e., English Spell Well Contest and Sanskrit Shabdamanthan Spardha.
- The competition will be accessible on the student's dashboard between 8:00 AM and 3:30 PM.
- Students can attend both English and Sanskrit competitions on the same date.
- The last date for registration is 25th Oct 2025.

REWARDS - DISTRICT LEVEL COMPETITION (DLC)

- All participants will receive a physical participation certificate.
- Title holders will receive official winner certificates.
- Champions from each group/category will receive 100% sponsorship for the National Level Championship (NLC), as per the sponsorship criteria.
- Marks obtained in this competition will be considered for the overall ranking.
- All DLC participants will receive a complimentary preparatory book (PDF).
- Schools will receive prizes based on their students' participation in the respective group/category.

DLC PARTICIPATION FEE

The individual participation fee is Rs.250 + GST (Rs.295/-)

For sponsorship winners, the fee will be Rs.0, regardless of the group or category they belong to.

PREPARATORY BOOK

The preparatory book contains approximately 1,000 words and exercises specifically designed for the competition. These words and exercises are graded to align with the participants' age and class (standard).

Above Fees structure is exclusively for the school students.

Self-registered student have to pay the standard fees.



1. Competition Overview

- The District Level Competition (DLC) will be conducted online within the school premises, in the computer lab, under the supervision of the school team.
- Students must use the same login credentials provided in their selection letter.
- Once started, the test must be completed and submitted in one sitting. If the exam window is refreshed or closed, it cannot be restarted.
- Participation in SWI competitions is voluntary and not mandatory for any student.

2. Certificates:

- Every participant will receive a physical participation certificate.
- Title holders (Champion, Winner, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up) will receive a medal and winner certificate.
- Certificates will be dispatched to schools within one week after results are declared.
- Schools are responsible for distributing certificates to students.

3. Communication and Updates

- Important updates regarding the competition may be communicated to participants via student dashboard notifications, WhatsApp, SMS, email, or phone calls by the company or its authorized representatives.

4. Participation Fee

- 100% sponsorship is granted to ET toppers for the DLC round.
- Non-sponsored students must pay a participation fee of ₹250 + GST(Rs.295/-)
- Payment options:
 - Through the school coordinator (online/bank transfer to SWI).
 - Directly by students using the online payment facility from their dashboard.
- Fee details and payment status will be visible on the student's dashboard.
- Only selected students from the Entrance Test are eligible to participate in the DLC.

5. Qualification and Results

- The top performers in the DLC will qualify for the National Level Championship (NLC).
- In case of ties, a Virtual Oral Round will be conducted.
- Results will be shared with the school & visible on the student's dashboard within 20 days after the exam
- Ranking will be based on marks scored in the competition.

6. Technical & Conduct Guidelines

- Students must use a desktop/laptop with stable internet in the school computer lab.
- Mobile devices are not permitted.
- Any attempt to engage in unfair means, malpractice, or impersonation will lead to disqualification.
- Students must report on time as per the schedule issued by their school coordinator.

7. Disputes & Support

- Any discrepancy regarding participation, payment, or results must be reported by the school coordinator within 7 days of result declaration.
- Parents should report any queries or requests for assistance to their school coordinator or designated in-charge.
- The school coordinator will consolidate and communicate such matters to SWI for resolution.
- For exceptional cases requiring escalation, coordinators may reach out to support@spellwellindia.com with complete details, including the student's login ID.
- SWI's decision will be final and binding in all matters related to results, awards, and eligibility.

8. Terms & Conditions

- SWI reserves the right to change, modify, or update any rules, regulations, or schedules without prior notice.
- Participation in the competition implies acceptance of all rules and regulations.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Participation Process

Q: How will parents be informed if their child is selected to participate in the District Level Competition?

A: The school will notify parents/students directly. Students can also check their Student Dashboard to confirm whether the DLC participation option is available.

Q: What happens if the participation fee is not paid on time?

A: Students whose participation fee is not paid within the due date will not be able to participate. Only students with confirmed fee payment will have access to the preparatory material and competition login.

2. Payment Details

Q: What is the exact amount of the participation fee?

A: Students with 100% sponsorship do not need to pay. Non-sponsored students can participate by paying ₹250 + GST, which includes the preparatory material (ET/DLC Preparatory Book – PDF).

Q: Are there any alternative payment methods other than online payment or bank transfer?

A: Schools may, at their discretion, collect the fee on-site from parents/students and transfer it to SWI. Parents should confirm with their school coordinator about available payment options.

Q: Will there be a refund if the student decides not to participate after paying the fee?

A: Fees once paid are non-refundable under any circumstances.

3. Competition Format

Q: How will the Virtual Oral Round be conducted, and what is expected from students during this round?

A: The Virtual Oral Round will be conducted online (via Zoom or an equivalent platform). The school will share the joining link with students, and it will also be available on the Student Dashboard.

Q: What should students prepare for if they participate in the District Level Competition?

A: Students should study both the official preparatory book and their school textbooks.

Q: How can I download the preparatory book?

A: After DLC enrollment is confirmed, students can download the preparatory book from their Student Dashboard under the "Upcoming Competitions" section. Schools may also guide parents/students in case of difficulty. A tutorial video is available here: <https://youtu.be/yEKJuTu3tnw>

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

4. Results and Certificates

Q: How will parents be notified when the results are available?

A: Results will be shared with the school, and schools will notify their students. Students can also view their results and answer sheets on the Student Dashboard after release.

Q: What should parents do if there's a delay in receiving the awards or certificates?

A: Parents should report such delays to their school coordinator or in-charge, who will then coordinate with SWI for resolution.

5. Updates and Notifications

Q: What is the best way for parents to ensure they receive all important updates regarding the competition?

A: Parents should stay connected with the school coordinator for regular updates. Additionally, students should:

- Link their WhatsApp number to the SWI Student Dashboard
- Regularly check the Notice Section and Upcoming Competitions section on the dashboard.

6. Selection Criteria

Q: What are the criteria for selecting students for the District Level Competition based on the Entrance Test scores?

A: Typically, the top 30% of students from each school qualify for the DLC. In case of ties, more than 30% may be selected at the discretion of SWI.
