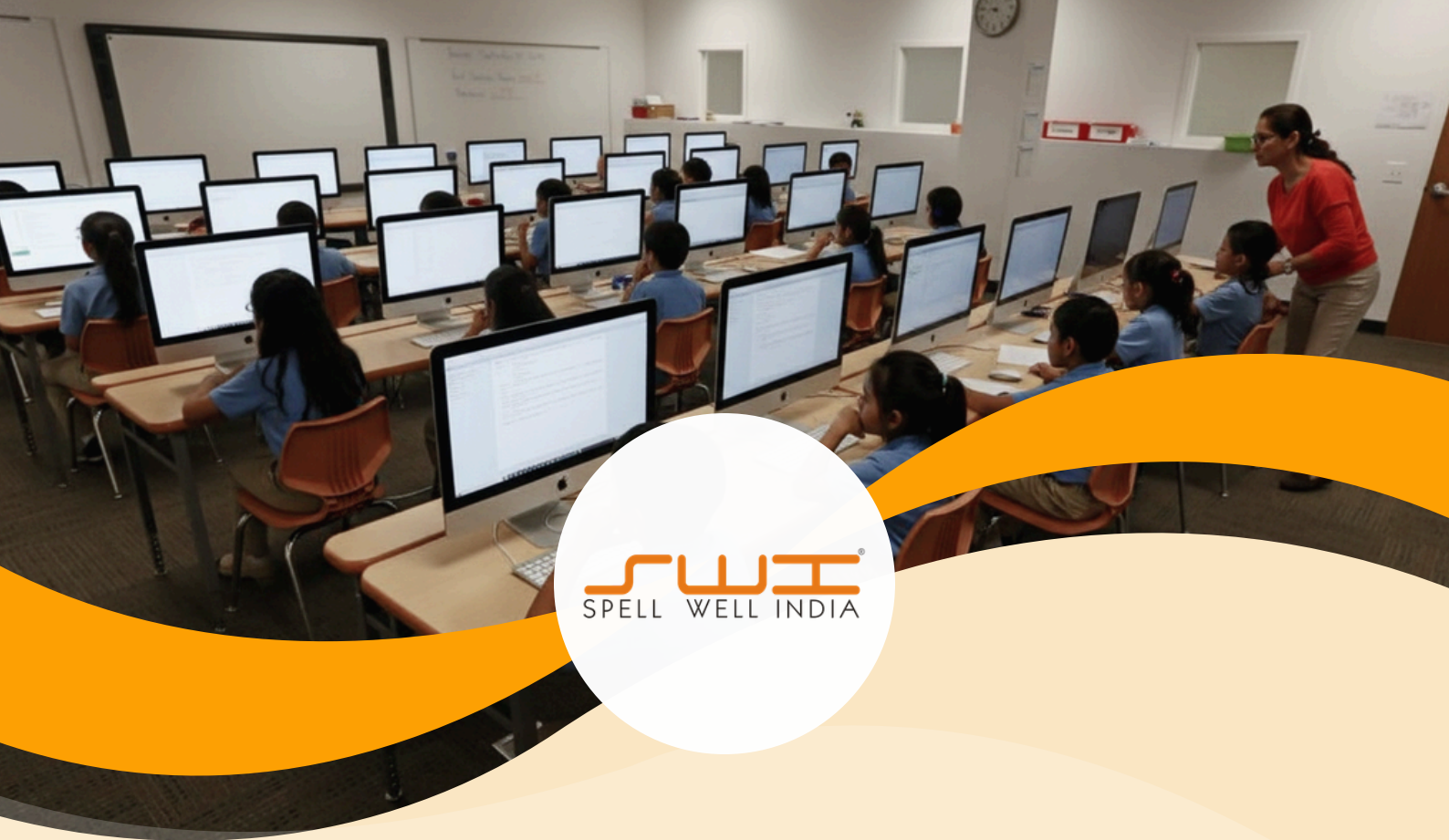

STAGES OF EXAMINATION

1. Trial Test
2. Entrance Test (ET)
3. District Level Championship (DLC)
4. National Level Championship (NLC)

FREE TRIAL TEST

- The Trial Test is free for all students.
- Students have the option to independently attend the trial test.
- Students have the convenience of accessing the trial test 24/7.
- Students can attempt the 'Trial Test' by logging into their student dashboard with the following link: <https://competition.spellwellindia.com/> using their login ID and password.
- The Trial Test can be attempted multiple times to get familiar with the examination rounds and question patterns.

ENTRANCE TEST

- Participation fees are required for students to take part in the ET.
- The participation fee for the ET can be submitted as instructed by the school.
- The ET will be visible on the student's dashboard on the examination date communicated by the school.
- Students may appear for both English and Sanskrit examinations on the same date.
- Entrance Test will be conducted within the school premises.
- The Entrance Test will have a duration of 10 minutes and will carry a total of 20 marks.

REWARDS "ENTRANCE TEST" (ET)

- Digital Participation Certificates and Acknowledgement Letters for all ET Participants.
- The marks obtained in this examination will be considered for selection in progressive rounds.
- Top-performing students will receive 100% sponsorship for the progressive round i.e. DLC, as per the selection criteria.



COMPETITION RULES

Rules & regulations

- Students can download their certificates upon successful completion of the Entrance Test.
- For any assistance or queries, students are advised to seek help from their respective schools.
- Important updates regarding the examination may be sent to participants through WhatsApp, SMS, Email, or phone calls by the company or its authorized associates *only if required.
- Students are advised to review available notices and exam details available on their respective dashboards from time to time.

Selection Criteria:

- Students who secure the highest marks from each group will be selected to represent their school in the progressive round without paying any additional fees.
- Students who achieve the qualifying marks will be eligible to participate in the progressive round by paying the standard fees.
- Students who have not secured the passing marks and still want to participate can re-attempt the upcoming ET by paying the prescribed fees and get a chance to be selected for the progressive round.

Sponsorship Criteria:

- Top performing students will receive 100% sponsorship for the progressive round i.e., the DLC, as per the selection criteria.
- To be eligible for sponsorship by SWI, students must achieve a minimum of 60% marks.
- Sponsorship will be awarded to the top performer in each group based on the standard selection criteria determined by the SWI jury.

The management reserves the right to change, modify, or update any rules and regulations related to the examination and associated events without prior notice.

CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE IN LINGUISTICS (COEIL)

Applicable to CoEiL participants

1. No Additional Fees for Progressive Rounds:

Students qualifying for the progressive rounds will not be required to pay any additional participation fees.

2. Qualification Requirement:

Students must qualify in any one of the three Entrance Test attempts to become eligible for the progressive rounds. Students who do not qualify in all three attempts will not be eligible to participate in the progressive rounds for the current academic year. However, they may continue to access the learning resources and other applicable benefits provided under the CoEiL module and utilize them to strengthen their linguistic skills and prepare for participation in the subsequent academic year.

3. Eligibility for Attempts:

- Additional Entrance Tests (up to 3 attempts) will be provided only to those students who do not qualify for the progressive rounds in their first or second attempt.
- Students who fail to qualify in all three attempts will not be eligible to participate in any progressive round.

4. Acknowledgement Letter Dispatch:

- The Participation Acknowledgement Letter for the First Round will be dispatched as per the prescribed schedule.
- The acknowledgement letters for ET Attempts 2 and 3 will be dispatched together upon completion of the third Entrance Test.
- Acknowledgement of the ET Attempt 2 result will be shared with the respective schools/CoEiL Centres.

5. School Discretion

Participation under the CoEiL module and the utilization of the available attempts shall be entirely at the discretion of the respective school.

6. Final Authority:

Spell Well India reserves the right to interpret, amend, or modify these rules and regulations whenever necessary. The decision of Spell Well India shall be final and binding in all matters related to the CoEiL module.

FOR SELF REGISTERED STUDENTS

Rules & regulations

- The ET participation fee for self-registered students is Rs. 299 + GST.

- Self-registered students will be required to take a proctored examination for virtual monitoring during the examination. Please refer to the notices section on your dashboard for detailed guidance.
- Students are advised to carefully review the latest notices on their dashboard for important updates.
- Examination will be available on students' dashboard during the time slot mentioned for the respective examination.
- Selection email containing acknowledgement letter will be sent to the top 50% of participants.
- The participation fee for the Entrance Test can be submitted to SWI via online payment.
- Virtual Oral round is not part of ET, but can be conducted only in case of any discrepancies or the flags raised by the system while evaluating answer key.
- Students can download their certificates upon successful completion of the Entrance Test.
